Directions to Rick Etsell, naval architect, Pacific Motor Boat Design:

The office is in my home at **2618 Washington Blvd, Anacortes, Washington**. Anacortes is about 1.5 hours north of Seattle on Fidalgo Island (which is connected to the mainland with a bridge.) At the western end of Washington Highway 20, on Fidalgo Island, is a Washington State Ferry terminal, which provides service to the San Juan Islands and Sydney, British Columbia. My home is a short distance past the ferry terminal, so you can simply follow the signs to the ferry terminal, but go straight instead of right at the terminal. (Step 6 below). Washington Blvd is about 1/2 mile past the terminal on your right.

Here are the detailed directions from Mapquest, with a little added editing:

1. From I-5 take the WA-20 exit- **exit number 230**- toward BURLINGTON/ANACORTES.
2. At the off-ramp turn LEFT onto **WA-20/ W**. Continue to follow WA-20 W. 11.7 miles
3. WA-20 W becomes **WA-20 SPUR W**. 2.7 miles
4. At Anacortes, highway turns SLIGHT RIGHT onto **COMMERCIAL AVE/ WA-20 SPUR**. 1.3 miles (25 mph)
5. Turn LEFT onto **12TH ST/ WA-20 SPUR**. (You'll see signs for Anacortes/San Juan Islands Ferry.) Continue to follow WA-20 SPUR. 3.1 miles (30 mph, then 40 mph.)
6. As road veers right to the Ferry terminal, use the left lane to go straight, onto **SUNSET AVE**. 0.5 miles (30 mph.)
7. After passing the Skyline Marina Community on the left, continue on Sunset Avenue to **Washington Blvd**, a divided boulevard on the right. A sign in the median says "Sunset Cove".
8. Proceed part way up the hill on **Washington Blvd**. **2618** is on the left side of the street about half way up the hill. It is the first house after a series of vacant lots. You will need to go past the house to the next u-turn break in the median, then come back down to 2618.
9. Office is on the lower level – take the stairs around the south side of the house to the back door entrance.
