We should have won this game, We were leading 2-0 early in the first half. Credit to Spurs, they fought back to draw 2-2. However the first half ended 4-2. We lost

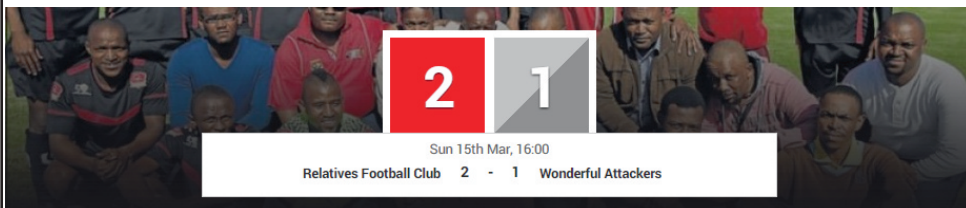

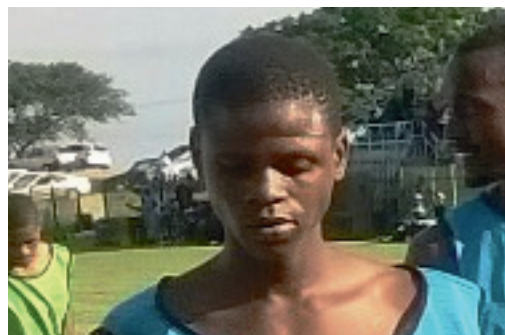

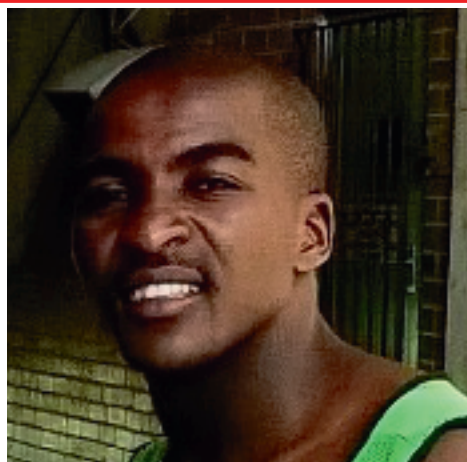
